PHILOSOPHY

All persons are entitled to opportunities to continue their growth and maximize their individual potential. By providing systematic training and exposure to life experiences of all types, adults with disabilities can become less dependent on other people and become valued and active members of the community.

GOALS

To provide a meaningful variety of experiences and training opportunities to maximize a person's independence in areas of community, home/life, recreation, pre-vocational training, functional academics, and self-management.

SERVICE APPROACH AND SETTINGS

Primary programming is offered on a full-time or part-time basis to develop, maintain, and utilize a wide variety of functional skills. The training is provided in a small group format or on an individual basis. Settings for the program include classroom, simulated apartment, Industry area, and a variety of community locations.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to enroll in Shares, Inc. Community Integration Services, individuals must be eligible for or involved in one of the following programs:

- Medicaid Waivers- Shares, Inc. provides services under Family Supports Waiver (FSW) and Community Integration and Habilitation Waiver (CIH).
- Group Homes or other residential programs for persons with developmental disabilities.
- OBRA Services- Nursing Home residents with developmental disabilities and referred by the State for day services.
- If none of the above are applicable, an individual who meets eligibility criteria may choose to private pay for services at the current Medicaid Waiver reimbursement rates until a funding source is secured.

Living Skills Day Program offers training and instruction in:

- Socialization skills
- · Communication skills
- · Daily Living Skills
- · Self-help skills
- Health maintenance
- Hygiene
- Nutrition
- Exercise
- Sensory Integration activities
- Cognitive stimulation
- Pre-vocational skills
- Volunteering
- Community awareness, training and utilization of community resources
- Functional academic skill
