- Advocacy Education- Assisting people with Developmental Disabilities to know how to advocate for their individual rights and their responsibilities in order to have their rights protected.
- **Resource and Referral** Helping individuals with Developmental Disabilities and their families to locate needed resources and to assist in the referral to community agencies.
- **Transitioning** Assisting individuals and families to transition from school to work or work to retirement.
- **Counseling and Support** Assisting to help individuals cope with any personal or work problems, achieve self-awareness, develop decision making skills, and to foster self-advocacy.
